

Overall, Fromm holds his argument through a course of winded quotes from Bertrand Russell in the beginning chapters. As noted by a previous review, there isn't a real consistency in terms of chronological examples or research presented (as noted in the preface). *On Disobedience* is a bit more preachy and a sort of guide for an individual's understanding of his role in society and amongst humanity.
