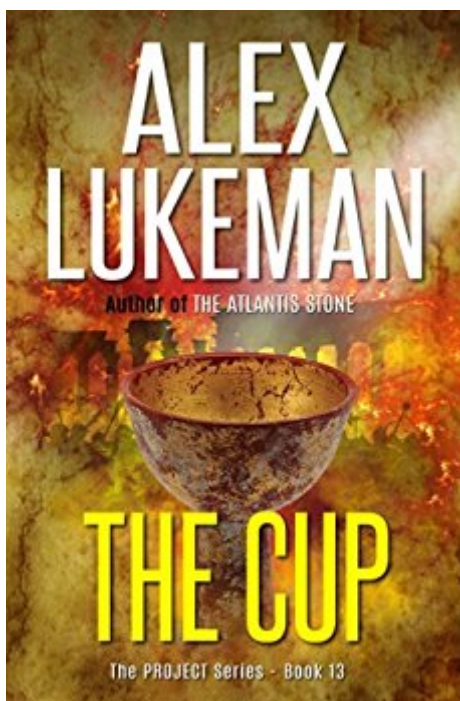

But I was really left empty, confused and frustrated by the end of this one. The writing was too simple and these deeper subjects need much more depth to work. Also, the port of Atlanta? The author must do better even if the next book takes longer to write. Nick and Selena and all these great characters deserve it. And we, the reader, deserve it.

This is a well written, very descriptive, fast paced plot with lots of action and some twists and turns. In other words, like the other twelve books in this series.
