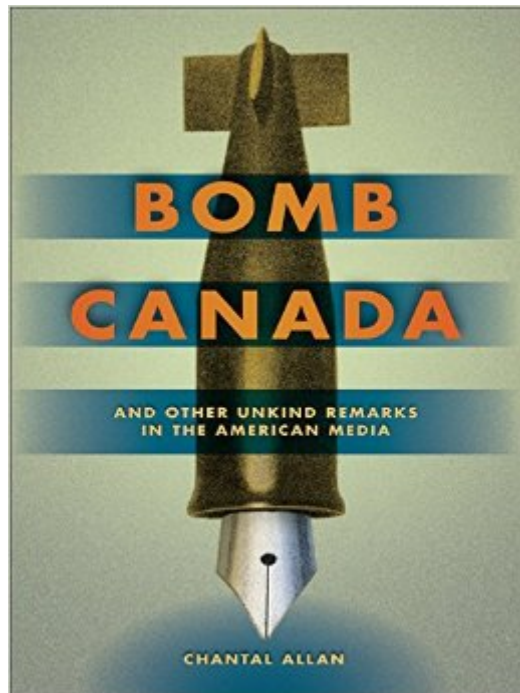

It begins with Canada's refusal to join the American Revolution,

escaped slaves, Fenians, Louis Riel, the Reciprocity Treaty of 1911, refusal to embargo Cuba, Trudeaumania, the daring Canadian rescue of US diplomats from 1979 Tehran, 9/11, mad cow and climate change.
